### **The Samueli Institute Opens New Headquarters Office in Alexandria, Virginia**

**Alexandria, VA —June 26, 2007—**The Samueli Institute will open the doors on its new headquarters at 1737 King Street in the heart of Old Town Alexandria, VA on Monday, July 2. The new space of 27,000 square feet will accommodate the Institute's growth projections over the next seven to 10 years.

"We simply outgrew our current location," said Kendra Calhoun, Chief Operating Officer of the Institute. "Plus, this new space expands our capabilities for meetings and scientific sessions." Over the past five years, the Institute has grown from five staff to 25 staff and more than 17 scientific consultants who spend time at the Institute. The Institute, according to Calhoun, expects to see additional staff growth over the next 18 months.

The Institute will immediately occupy 17,000 square feet of the space and has sublet the additional space to Buchanan Ingersoll & Rooney PC, one of the oldest law firms in the country. The Institute spent more than \$1 million building out the space to meet its needs for staff offices and meeting rooms. Other new additions to the sixth floor space include a full-service board room outfitted with wireless microphones, state-of-the-art video teleconferencing capability on 72-inch screen, cable/dish receiver with high definition audio-visuals, a conference room that seats 50 classroom style, a yoga/meditation room, a complete kitchen/galley, a library, and additional break-out meeting rooms.

The building is managed by Lincoln Property Company. The space renovations were designed by The M Group, and Dietze Construction served as the general contractor, with coordination from Corporate Services Group.

An official grand opening will be held later this fall.
